Subjects:-

1. Economics (two posts) ---- Both unreserved
2. Political Science (one post) ---- Reserved for ST(H)
3. History (one post) ----- Unreserved
4. Education (one post) ----- Reserved for SC

1. The age of a candidate should not be more than 43 Years as on 01/01/2017. It is relaxable upto 5 years for ST/SC candidates.
2. Candidates must have minimum 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subjects from an Indian University or an equivalent Degree from an accredited foreign University.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) to this clause 4.4.1, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET/ for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor.
4. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate or Master's level for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled categories for the purpose or eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to the teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying mark without including any grace mark procedure.
5. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Masters Degree prior to September 19, 1991.
6. Candidates who are in service must apply through proper channel with an NOC from the concerned authority.
